The undersigned is aware of the risks of injury, death and property damage that may result from , among other causes, the active or passive negligence of WAG, Inc., its associates or agents, Susan Rappillus and Dave Scheuner. The undersigned is voluntarily engaged in dog agility as a recreational activity with the knowledge of the risks or injury, death, property damage, and other risks, and assumes any and all known and unknown risks of injury, death and property damage that may result from participation in dog agility.
- 2. Release of Liability.** The undersigned releases WAG, Inc., its associates or agents, Susan Rappillus and Dave Scheuner from all liability to the undersigned and the undersigned's representatives, guardians, successors, assigns, heirs, and next of kin for all liability, claims, damage, or demands for personal injury, death, or property damage, to the undersigned or the undersigned's dog or dogs, arising from or related to this agreement. This release includes, without limitation, any personal injury, death, or property damage caused by the active or passive negligence of WAG, Inc., its associates or agents, Susan Rappillus and Dave Scheuner. The undersigned bears sole responsibility for any loss.
- 3. Knowing and Voluntary Execution.** The undersigned acknowledges that he or she has carefully read this agreement, understands its contents, and understands that this agreement includes and assumption of the risk of WAG, Inc., its associates or agents, Susan Rappillus and Dave Scheuner negligence and a release of their liability. Group Evening Agility Class Information

Hello Students: Please check closely the times for each class.

Reminder: No bitches in season in class

Additional class offerings may open up during the remainder of the year – please check back with us if you need a different class schedule. Classes missed are not refundable – you may be able to make up Wed or Thurs. classes on the opposite day – Mon. and Tues. classes have no alternate times.

Classes are 1 hour for seven weeks.

Single night drop-ins are \$20.00 for Intermediate and Advance levels only.

Evening Classes:

Pre-Agility Monday at 6:00pm. For dogs that have never been to an agility class. (Some off leash work, one dog at a time) Targeting, recalls, send-aways, sit, stay, come, tunnels, tire jump, weave poles, pause table, and some jumping.

Beginning 1 Monday at 7:15pm and Tuesday at 6:00pm Prerequisite: Pre-agility class.

Beginning 2 Monday at 8:30pm Prerequisite: Beginning 1 level class. There will be some off leash training in this class. Low teeter and low a-frame.

Beginning 3 A and B Tuesday at 6:30 and 7:45 pm Prerequisite: Beginning 2 level class. Dogs should be comfortable with all the equipment. Teeter is full height. Weave poles have guides only in 3A and may have no guides in 3B.

Intermediate 1 Weds at 8:30pm or Thursday at 6:00pm will be for dogs that have taken at least three beginning classes. The dogs should be able to perform all full height contact equipment and have good contact performances and weave poles with no guides. All work is off leash. Sequencing with about 10 obstacles.

Intermediate 2 Weds or Thursday at 7:15pm are for the novice dogs that are almost or already competing in agility trials.. All off leash training. Sequencing 12-13 obstacles.

Advanced Weds at 6:00pm or Thursday at 8:30pm are for the dogs that are competing in at least the Open Level of Agility. Sequencing 16-20 obstacles. Good distance work.

Directions to 10925 Bruceville Rd. Look for the K9 Facility sign posted at driveway. Drive straight down the driveway to the lighted arena at rear of property. Please park in the parking lot to the right of the arena.

Coming from Hwy 99 South Bound take the Grant Line exit (next exit after Elk Grove Blvd) and immediately turn left on frontage road. Turn at first right on Kammerer Rd. Go approx. 4 miles till it dead ends at Bruceville and turn left. We are the 3rd driveway on the left. Sign at the driveway.

Coming from Hwy 99 North Bound take the Grant Line Exit, stay to right and circle back **OVER** the freeway bridge. Turn left on the frontage rd (Stockton Blvd) and then turn right on Kammerer. Go approx. 4 miles until it dead ends at Bruceville Rd and turn left.. We are the 3rd driveway on the left. Sign at the driveway.

Coming from Hwy 5 South Bound, take Hood Franklin Exit and turn left at stop sign. Go Approx 1 mile. At the stop sign (Franklin Rd) turn left. Go approx. 100 yards to Bilby Rd and turn right. At stop sign (Bruceville Rd) turn right. Go approx. 1 mile to our driveway on the left. Sign at the driveway.

Coming from Hwy 5 North Bound. **Take the Hood Franklin Exit & turn right at stop sign. Go Approx. 1 mile. At the stop sign (Franklin Rd) turn left. Go approx. 100 yards to Bilby Rd & turn right. At stop sign (Bruceville Rd) turn right. Go approx. 1 mile to driveway on the left.** Sign at the driveway.

Students

Please arrive 10-15 minutes early to class. To give your dogs time to stretch and relieve themselves prior to class. It also gives us a few minutes for any general announcements. For the first Pre-agility class – be ready to go at 5:45 as we have a lengthy familiarization to go over with all students.

Please bring with you to class the following items if you are able:

- 1) Flat snap type collar for the dog. Preferably one the dog can not get out of.
- 2) 6' flat cloth or leather lead. Chain leashes make noise on the equipment and can scare a noise sensitive dog. Please, no Flexi-leads during class training or pinch collars. A Halti or Gentle leaders can be used while in the alley ways, but not in the class arena.
- 3) Treats that the dog loves. Stored in a plastic bag in your pocket is ok. Bait bags are better. Do NOT feed your dog prior to coming to class. The treats should be in small pieces so the dog does not get full. Example of treats can be hard cheese, hot dogs, dried liver, chicken, processed dog treats like Roll Over or Beggin Strips. Make it something he really loves. If your dog cannot eat certain dog foods and is on a special diet, please let me know before the actual class starts so we don't feed it something it can't tolerate.
- 4) Please wear comfortable and safe running shoes. Tennis shoes with good tread are fine.

Reminder: If your bitch comes into season during or just before class starts, she will not be allowed to attend any level of agility class This is a safety rule we find necessary because we can not allow the male dogs to become distracted by a female in season and not pay attention to what we are asking them to do in agility. We will reschedule your classes for the next session if you have to miss more than two classes. The beginning classes are the foundation of agility and if you miss too many important classes it is hard to catch up to the level of the class. Each dog is different so each dog will be evaluated prior to coming back into class after missing some classes.

At the beginning of class we will introduce ourselves and all the students will get a chance to introduce themselves. If you have a dog that is not as sociable as you would like and may have trouble around other dogs, please speak up at this time and let the others know to be more aware while around your dog. Some people can be lazy about watching the dogs when in a group. Not all dogs like to have other dogs sniff them. So please keep a close eye and a fairly short leash on your dog for the safety of the group. The surroundings and the new dogs are all very new and exciting to the dogs. The first couple of weeks you will see the dogs be very excited and more rowdy then normal. When the dogs become accustom to the surroundings and the other dogs, you will find them to quiet down some and start to pay more attention to what you, the handler, are doing.

In the Pre-Agility class we teach the dogs a few basic obedience commands that are important on the agility field. Sit, stay and come are taught, along with targeting, send-aways and enthusiastic recalls. We will introduce tunnels, the table, weave poles and low jump standards. All these things are the basis for good agility dogs. And this class is a prerequisite to our Beginning level 1 agility class.
